Please bring a camping chair or similar if you wish to sit down and please ensure that you remain at the wall side of the track and do not go over to the children. This is to ensure that we are able to safeguard all pupils.

Some parents have volunteered to sell hot drinks and bottles of cold water at the sports day. If you would like to purchase a hot drink, please bring a reusable cup with you and we will fill it. Please also bring cash as we are unable to take other forms of payment.

We will also be holding a bucket collection at the Sports Day with proceeds from this and the refreshments going to Candlelighters.
