Thank you

There will not be a newsletter next week and therefore this is the last formal newsletter that you will receive this year. I would like to take the opportunity to thank a number of people.

Firstly, thank you to the children at our school. Whenever I have shown people around our school this year, they have regularly commented on the calm, purposeful atmosphere that we have in school. This is down to the children and their positive learning behaviour and attitudes towards others. This does not mean that we do not have any behaviour that is unacceptable. When we do though, children respond positively and in a reflective manner to the discussions that we have which leads to changes in behaviour in the future.

I also want to thank the Year 6 children for working so hard all through their school journey which has led to extremely high results in their SATS. Similarly, the Year 4 children worked hard on their Times Tables and produced results which are the highest that we have had in the Multiplication Tables Check. The Year 1 and 2 children have worked hard with our new phonics scheme and our Phonics Screening Check results are now back at 80%. The years in between, although they don't have a statutory assessment, have still worked hard in all areas of the curriculum to ensure that they are as ready as they can be for the next year.

Secondly, thank you to all our parents and carers. The school is a big team as you all know. We have had countless parents this year bringing their children to us, either ready for Reception or Nursery next year or in the middle of the year, who have said that current parents or carers have recommended our school. This makes me feel very humble. You support your children and support us in school and for this we are grateful. I do ask that we have a huge push on attendance and punctuality next year as the government are changing the way that they code this and measure this and we are currently low in terms of average attendance and the number of children who are persistently absent. I hope that we can all work together to improve this.

Finally, I want to thank my staff team and the governors. They work tirelessly for the benefit of your children. Most do tasks which are beyond their job description as they see that it would help someone at that point of time and this is what makes our team work so well. I am lucky to have such a dedicated bunch of people working with me.
