#### News from this week

#### Lockdown and Fire practice

We had a practice of our lockdown procedures yesterday while many children were out doing the 1k. The children all quickly moved inside where we accounted for them all quickly. We were proud of how sensibly they behaved.

We have also held a fire evacuation practice this morning. The children and staff were all evacuated from the building and registered outside in just over 2 minutes.

We remind the children of these emergency procedures each term in one of the first assemblies of the term and practise them regularly.

## Phonics Learning Walk

Some of the Senior Leaders had a walk through all the phonics lessons on Tuesday. It was lovely to see all the children so engaged in this vital teaching. The Reception children were only on day 2 of their full phonics teaching but were taking everything in their stride!
